


Alpine District Klondike Parking – February 5-6, 2016



Parking Information:

- 1) Roads into Lambert Park Klondike area and into rodeo grounds parking lot are icy and snowy, 4-wheel drive vehicles are required. If you do not have a 4WD vehicle, you can drop your gear and boys off at the bottom of the Klondike area and park at the church (take shuttle back to Klondike).
- 2) All 4WD vehicles can unload gear and boys at the Klondike pavilion area. Please be patient Once unloaded, you will need to move vehicles to one of the parking areas at rodeo grounds or church.
 - a. Exception: There is very limited parking at the Klondike site for ~20 vehicles. *One vehicle per troop* may park in this area until it is full. Once full, all other vehicles must park at the rodeo grounds or church.
 - b. The small parking lot next to the pavilion is reserved for staff vehicles and drop-off/pick-up area.
- 3) If the rodeo grounds lot becomes full, all other vehicles will park at the church. There are some small cleared areas in the field near the rodeo grounds turn-off. If they are frozen you can park there, but if muddy/soft you should avoid them as it is new, soft fill dirt and you may get stuck.
- 4) We are allowed to park only on the north side of the church (~100 stalls). East and west side parking are reserved for Saturday morning baptisms. Shuttle will run from church to Klondike Friday night from ~4:30 to 6:30 pm and from Klondike to church Saturday morning from ~10:00 to end.
- 5) Please DO NOT park on Box Elder Drive. It is illegal (you can be ticketed by Alpine city) and makes it challenging for local residents. Thank you for your cooperation and consideration in helping us make the challenging parking situation work as well as possible.
